## PRESENTERS:

### HONORABLE ARCHIE B. HAYWARD



Judge Archie B. Hayward, Jr. is a native of Lee County, Florida. Admitted to the Florida Bar in 1984, he graduated with both his BA and JD degree from the University of Florida. He also has his AA degree from Edison Community College / FSW. Judge Hayward was appointed to the County Court for the 20th Judicial Circuit in January 2008 and elected to a six year term in 2010.

Prior to his judicial appointment, Judge Hayward was employed with Florida Rural Legal Services as the managing attorney of the Senior Advocacy Program. Before coming on board with Florida Rural Legal Service, Judge Hayward had a solo general practice for 9 years with a focus on criminal defense law. From 1984 to 1989 he worked as an Assistant Public Defender in the 20th Judicial Circuit.

In addition to practicing law, Judge Hayward has taught as an adjunct paralegal instructor at Edison College /FSW where he currently serves as an advisory board member. Judge Hayward has also worked as a volunteer child support hearing officer for the County Court Administration office of the 20th Judicial Circuit.

Judge Hayward has a deep and abiding commitment to his community, and serves on the boards of various community agencies and non-profits. He is also an active member of his church and several community service organizations.

### HONORABLE DEVIN S. GEORGE



Judge George was appointed to the bench in 2016 by Governor Rick Scott. She serves in the Lee County Court division presiding over criminal cases, civil cases, municipal ordinances, county ordinances and traffic cases. Prior to her appointment, Judge George worked for ten years at the 20th Judicial Circuit State Attorney's Office in Lee County.

She is a native of Michigan, migrating to Florida in 2005 with her husband. Lee County has become home to Judge George and her family where she continues to firmly establish roots in the community that she hopes to call home for a long time to come.

### HONORABLE JOSEPHINE GAGLIARDI



Josephine Gagliardi was appointed to the County bench by Governor Jeb Bush in 2006. As a county judge she hears both civil and criminal matters. The criminal matters are misdemeanors, and the civil matters concern litigation with the jurisdictional amount of below \$15,000. She also hears traffic and municipal ordinance violations. For the past nine years, she along with another judge has volunteered to handle cases for the Felony Adult Drug Court program. This program assists addicts to recover, attain sobriety and become productive members of society.

Judge Gagliardi is a member of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, the Florida Court Education Council, Florida Bar Rules of Judicial Administration Committee, and she is the Editor of the Courier, the newsletter of the Conference of County Court Judges of Florida.

Judge Gagliardi is very active in her community volunteering her time with the Boy Scouts of America, and the PACE center for girls advisory board. She is a member of Rotary South, and other legal and civil organizations. She enjoys volunteer teaching and has taught bond, post judgment and landlord tenant issues to her fellow County Court judges.

She earned her Bachelor's from the University of Pittsburgh and her Juris Doctor from Antioch School of Law. She is married and the mother of twin adult sons
